

CONFIGURING IMAGES FOR DIGITAL PROJECTION

Images on CDs should be:

- Image Size: long dimension = 1024 pixels
- Resolution: 72 ppi
- File Format: JPEG
- Color Space: sRGB preferred
- Do not include other data on the CD.
- File name: 2 digits-first initial last name.JPEG

Example: 01-KDoyle.jpeg

FOR PRINT DISPLAY

Print images should be:

- Image Size (whichever is larger):
long dimension must be at least 10 inches

or

total image must be at least 80 inches square (8x10, 4x20, etc.)

- Mounted on a firm surface
- Mounting surface may be temporary or permanent, oversize or not.

This is a call for members who make prints to come forward and share their work with the world. I love this job of being Exhibits Chair for the club -- if I have prints to hang, that is.



Please! Next time we have an exhibit, get involved and share your work with the world. You never know who might look at your work and be inspired with a feeling!


