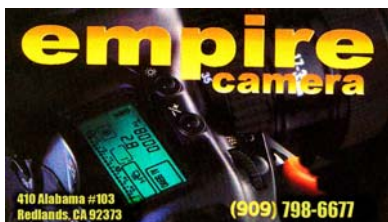
She uses her Canon Rebel SLR to photograph animals and flowers. Currently, she is working on mastering Photoshop Elements.

Sandie Watkins “discovered” RCC on-line. Formerly, she was a custom decorator. Now, she is a middle school principal in Hemet.

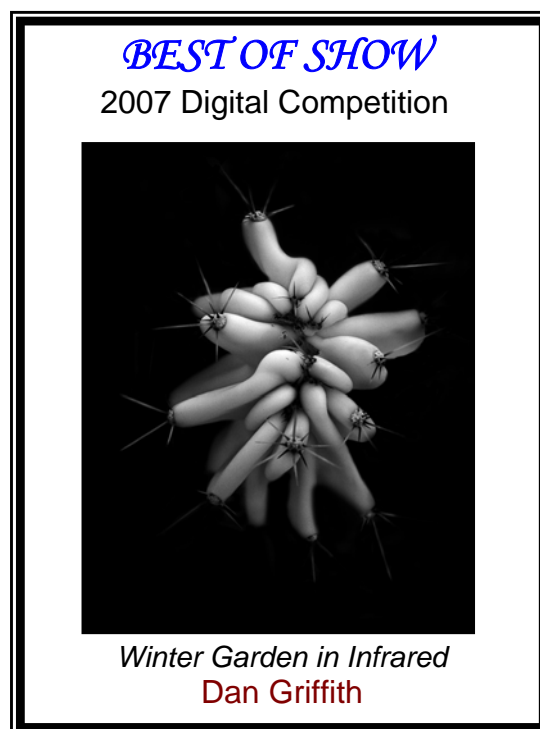
