Digital submissions: Special file naming protocol for scavenger hunt only. *Example:* **01-Sept08-BReece 01** is the category **-Sept08** is the date **-BReece** is your first initial & last name. This naming protocol will group all of the pictures together by category. Images are to be entered on a Windows readable CD. Each image file must be in sRGB color space and JPG format, with a file size of less than 3000KB (3MB). Resolution should be at least 1280 pixels on the long side and no less than 72 ppi.

Print submissions: If you present a print, bring 8"x10" or larger.




